NYPD continues to meet with hand-selected individuals, excluding critics

Broad coalition of Muslim organizations to announce community demands

Following the meeting orchestrated by the NYPD this past Tuesday with a few hand-selected individuals, the NYPD is holding yet another meeting with persons of its own choosing. Today's meeting purposely excludes community leaders and organizations that have been requesting meetings with Commissioner Kelly for over a year, since the news broke of the *Third Jihad* airing.

Despite these calls, Commissioner Kelly has persistently refused to discuss the merit of the NYPD actions. Just today, the Associated Press released another troubling NYPD document which details the NYPD's discriminatory surveillance of New York's Muslim communities. The document outlines the strategy for spying on New York's Syrian population, with a particular "focus on the smaller Muslim community." At the heels of such increasingly revealing reports, increasing community mobilization and mounting public pressure from Muslim communities, lawmakers, and even the FBI, the NYPD is manipulatively trying to hold sham meetings without addressing the concerns of the community or admitting the NYPD actions as wrong if not illegal.

The agenda of these closed meetings remains predetermined and unresponsive to the questions and demands being raised by local leaders and organizations, and mirrors the NYPD's pattern of secrecy and blatant disregard for accountability to the broader Muslim communities and the general Public.
